NEW RACING RULES ADOPTED

Rule Change: ARSD 20:04:17:05, Participants; and patrons' duty to abide by rules. The effect of this rule change is to prohibit licensees from giving illegal instructions.

The reason for this amendment is to preserve the integrity and security of racing.

Rule Change: ARSD 20:04:22:61, Exclusions from jockey's weight. The effect of this rule change is to add safety vests, over-girth and breast collars to the list of items that are not included in a jockey's weight.

The reason for this amendment is to conform to racing standards and provide uniformity in determining what equipment is not included a jockey's weight.

Proposed Rule Change: ARSD 20:04:23:01, Bridle and whip weight and length. The effect of this rule change is to reduce the maximum weight of a whip from one pound to eight ounces.

The reason for this amendment is to standardize the weight of riding whips and to ensure for more humane treatment of race horses.

Rule Change: ARSD 20:04:23:02, Use of certain shoes prohibited-Exception. The effect of this amendment is to prohibit horse shoes with toe grabs greater than two millimeters to be worn on front hooves of horses while racing or training.

The reason for this amendment is to prevent injuries and protect both horses and jockeys during racing.

New Rule: ARSD 20:04:23:01, Whip to be used for safety, correction and encouragement only. The effect of this new rule would be to provide guidelines for the humane use of the jockey's whip.

The reason for this new rule is to preserve the integrity and security of racing and provide for more humane use of the jockey's whip.

New Rule: ARSD 20:04:23:02, Prohibited use of the whip. The effect of this new rule would be to create a list of prohibited practices of the jockey's whip in the ordinary course of running a race.

The reason for this new rule is to preserve the integrity and security of racing and to prohibit inhumane uses of the jockey's whip.

New Rule: ARSD 20:04:29:14, Education courses required for renewal. The effect of this new rule would be to require licensees seeking renewal of trainer's licenses or owner-trainer's licenses to complete at least four hours of continuing education each calendar year.

The reason for this new rule is to ensure that trainers receive continuing education relating to health and welfare of horses as well as labor laws, as they pertain to the trainer's employees.

TRACK RULES

Aberdeen & Ft. Pierre

A. GENERAL RULES

1. The starting ability of all two year olds and older horses which have never started at a race track recognized by the South Dakota Commission on Gaming must be approved by the starter or a state steward before the horses will be permitted to start.
2. All horses must be identified by a legible lip tattoo prior to the start of any race unless this requirement is waived by the stewards.
3. All races in this condition book will be written for a weight of 124 pounds unless otherwise stated by the conditions of that race or the nomination form for a stakes race. Maidens receive least preference in overnight races.
4. Applications for stalls shall be made in advance with the General Manager. Payments for stalls must be made in full with the application. Stalls assigned on first come basis. If a walker spot is needed it must be in the request for stalls.
5. No dogs shall be allowed on the grounds without being leashed or confined. Any loose dogs found on the grounds shall be considered at large and taken to the Metro Animal Control Facility.
6. South Dakota Bred eligibility is determined by reference to South Dakota Rules of Racing.
7. Nomination and sustain payments must be post marked by the date specified. The United States Postal Service stamp indicating the date of mailing shall be final as the validity of the date of mailing of any nomination or sustaining payment. Metered mail is not acceptable.
8. There will be no refunds of accepted fees unless the race is cancelled.
9. Any check dishonored or returned by the bank for any reason shall cancel eligibility.
10. If any part of an entry is disqualified, it may disqualify all of the entry.
11. Officials of the Race Meet reserve the right to cancel, change distances, or postpone any race/or trials for any race reason which it deems good and sufficient. If horses are scratched from overnight races leaving only (5) horses or less, race may be cancelled and scratch horse or horses will lose eligibility to enter the following 3 days.
12. **The decision of the Racing Stewards in all matters shall be final** and entries are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating and/or starting a horse in the trials and/or the stakes agree to abide by the decision of the stewards.
13. **Changes of horse ownership must be approved by stewards prior to entry in any race. Transferred horses will not be allowed to race for 5 days. Claimed horses not included in the 5 days.**

14. HORSE PAPERS WILL BE HELD UNTIL ALL PAYMENTS ARE PAID IN FULL. Papers must be signed out by trainer "only."
15. Claiming: Claim must be placed in the claim box prior to the first horse exiting Paddock Area. Funds to claim a horse must be cash, cashiers check, or certified check and must be deposited in owners account unless claimant has an unencumbered amount of credit with the association sufficient to pay the claim.
16. All two year old maiden quarter horse races will be SD Bred Futurity and Open Futurity nominated preferred. Brown County track only.
17. All two year old non-starters must be gate approved. Tracks will have a starter or state steward available.
18. **Stall fee for 2009 in Aberdeen is \$100 of which \$50 will be credited back when horse starts or is on the official race program. Paid written stall applications receive priority. Stalls will fill fast, reserve early. Pony horses excluded. Ship in stalls must be reserved. Call for your assigned stalls. Horses in unassigned stalls will be moved.**
19. **Horse papers must be in race office to receive race dates. If you cannot make first weekend send papers to receive favorable race date. Late papers receive race date they are recorded. Ship in horses send papers or faxed copy to be eligible to "enter."**
20. All owners must sign a form allowing the associations bookkeeper to deduct the saddling fee from their account.
21. All Hwt Preferred - Will use last 10 outs not lifetime earnings.
22. **All exercise riders MUST wear flack jacket and helmet.**

B. ELIMINATION TRIALS

1. A trial shall consist of no more than 8 horses. Derby trials discretion of stewards.
2. Trial races shall be run consecutively.
3. 8 horses or less shall be selected from the trials to participate in the finals.
4. An owner may nominate as many entries as desired. If one or more are withdrawn before the race, the owner shall specify which ones are withdrawn when making payments.
5. All eligible horses must be entered in Racing Secretary's Office three days (72 hrs) before the day of the race with exception of Memorial Day.
6. The selection of quarter horses for the stakes finals shall be on time basis. No adjustment will be made in recorded time of trials for head winds, etc. Should a malfunction occur with electric timers on any trial all finalists will then be selected by order of finish.

7. Should a horse be disqualified, he will be given the time of the horse he is immediately placed behind plus 1/100 of a second.
8. In the trials, if a stall gate fails to open, and/or money wagered on the horse is refunded to the public, such horse will be declared a non-starter and no liability will be incurred beyond refund of nominating, sustaining, and entry fees less 15%. If the race is declared a non-race all horses in said race will be declared non-starters.
9. The top 8 qualifying horses shall be eligible for the finals in SD bred races.

“NOTE”

Entries for Saturday races will be taken on Wednesdays and entries for Sunday races will be taken on Thursdays. Entries for Memorial Day will be taken Thursday afternoon May 21, 2009 at approximately 1 pm. Entries will not close before 11 am or 3 pm respectively. However, entries can be closed anytime after the above times without any additional notice.

Aberdeen entries for all stakes, handicap and highweight races will close at 10 am with the exception of Legion Stakes which will close at 2 pm, Thursday, May 21, 2009.

“Special Note” Horse papers or a copy of horse papers “must” be in race office to be “eligible to enter” over the phone or in person.

No entries taken without papers or copies of papers!

“STATE VETERINARIAN’S NOTE”

All horses brought to either South Dakota racetracks must have a current health certificate that will be presented to the racing secretary’s office and accompany the horse’s papers. This includes out of state as well as South Dakota horses, and must be dated within 10 days of entering the racetrack grounds. All horses from out of South Dakota must have proof of a negative test for EIA done within the last 12 months listed on the health certificate, unless originating from North Dakota, Nebraska or Montana. Any incomplete or inaccurate health certificates will be returned to the Board of Animal Health in the originating state. It is strongly recommended that all horses receive Equine Herpes Virus-1 (EHV-1) vaccination within 90 days of entry to South Dakota racetracks.

THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

When applying for stalls, each horse must be listed and the owners name, complete mailing address, and either the social security number or employer's federal identification number.

Also required is a complete name and mailing address for the trainers. If this information is not on the application, it will be returned and stalls will not be guaranteed.

Stall rent is \$100.00 per horse with \$50.00 returned if horse starts. You will be charged for any stalls reserved. Stall rent is due with the application. Any changes in stall assignments must be approved by the General Manager. Pony horse stalls will be \$50.00.

It is the owners' and trainers' responsibility to keep enough money on deposit with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper for jock mount and saddling fee for all horses entered. JOCK MOUNTS MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE FIRST RACE OF THE DAY. Noncompliance may result in forfeiture of purse monies.

Each horse earnings will be credited to the OWNERS SHEET. Owners will be issued 1099 forms on their earnings per requirement of the IRS. We need complete names, addresses and social security numbers for these records. You will not receive your earnings until we have this information. Lack of cooperation has caused this to be a huge problem and it must be CORRECTED BY YOUR COOPERATION.

A copy of all lease agreements must be filed with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper before payments will be credited to the leasee.

Post time is 1:00 P.M. CDT. 8 or more races daily.

Race distances will be 300, 350, 400, 440 for quarter horses 5, 5 1/2, 6, 7, and 9 furlongs for thoroughbreds. Approx. 660 yds. for mixed TB & QH.

All rules and/or new rules adopted by the State Racing Commission of the State of South Dakota will supercede any conditions of this track.

The South Dakota bred point money will be paid and sent with final owner statements.
