

# South Dakota Breeder's Certificate

A South Dakota Breeder's Certificate is a notarized document verifying a horse's status as South Dakota bred and therefore eligible for South Dakota bred monies. A South Dakota bred horse is defined as a horse *that is foaled in the State of South Dakota whose dam is owned, in whole, at the time of foaling by a bona fide resident of the State of South Dakota.* A bona fide resident of South Dakota is defined as a *person who meets the requirements of Article VII, Section I of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota and is eligible to vote in a South Dakota general election.*

A South Dakota Breeder's Certificate must be submitted to the secretary of the breed association in order to receive South Dakota Bred money. Only certified South Dakota bred horses are eligible for this incentive. Points are awarded on the place of finish as follows:

Placing in Race	Points	Point Value
1 <sup>st</sup>	49	The value of each point is determined at the end of the South Dakota racing season. The total amount of point money allocated for bred points by the South Dakota Commission on Gaming is divided equally between Quarter Horses and Thoroughbreds. Those amounts are further divided within the breeds by the total number of certified South Dakota bred horses that raced at the Ft. Pierre and Aberdeen meets, the end results being the point value for each breed.
2 <sup>nd</sup>	20	
3 <sup>rd</sup>	10	
4 <sup>th</sup>	7	
5 <sup>th</sup>	5	
6 <sup>th</sup>	4	
7 <sup>th</sup>	3

## VERY IMPORTANT

South Dakota Breeder's Certificates are due by 5:00 pm on the first day of racing at the Ft. Pierre meet. Horses not certified by this deadline will **not** be eligible for bred points during the Ft. Pierre meet. Certificates will once again be accepted on the first day of racing at the Aberdeen meet, allowing eligibility for points for the Aberdeen meet. Breeder's certificates will not be accepted after 5:00pm on the first day of racing in Aberdeen; no points will be awarded. There are **no exceptions** to these deadlines. Please certify your horses early!

The Association secretaries collect and process the certificates, including stamping the original registration papers 'South Dakota Bred,' during the first day of racing in Ft. Pierre and Aberdeen.

Mail your completed certificate(s), along with \$5.00 for each certificate, to the Association secretary listed below. Incomplete forms and/or forms received without payment will not be accepted. Do not send your original registration papers.
